Moreover, SEB and SEBx will benefit from JEDI's large deeptech ecosystem in Europe, including French-based deeptech startups, leading scientific teams, technology firms and public institutions that JEDI interacts with.

Since JEDI supports moonshot research in not only cyber/computing but also in the energy/environment fields, our partnership will strengthen SEB's efforts to become a leading catalyst in the sustainability transition" says **Nicolas Moch, Head of SEBx**, adding: "through innovation, SEBx aspires to build and power financial services in new ways, and collaborating with JEDI will help us on this journey.
